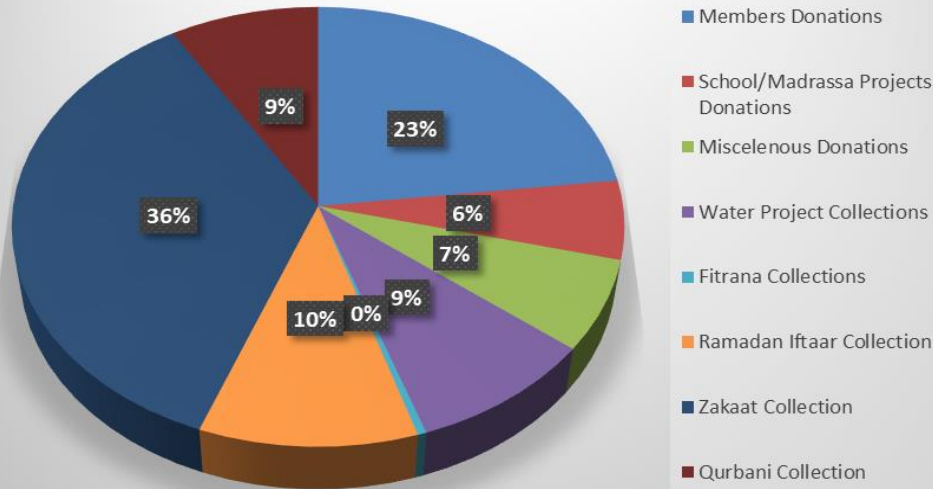

**Donations Collection**



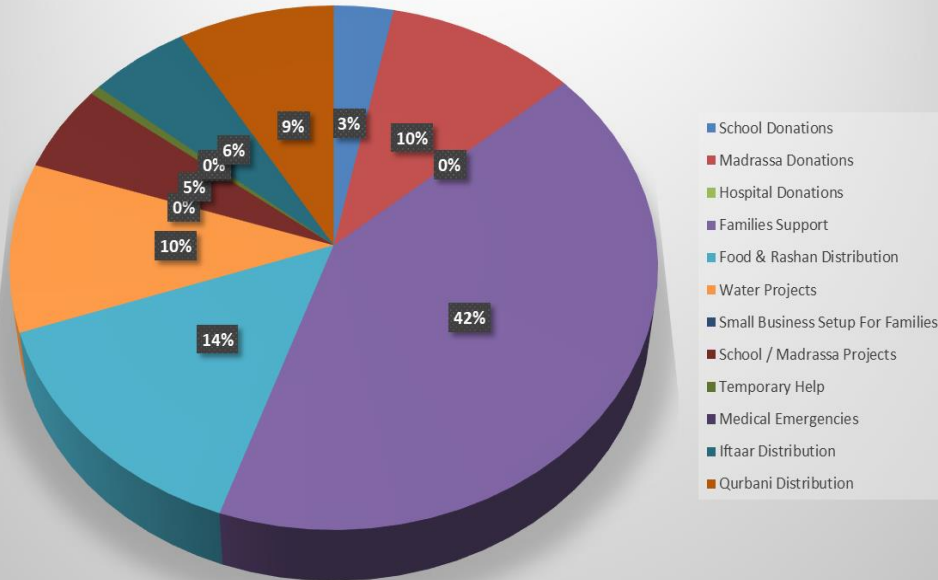
- Our sources of funds are, Zakat, Sadaqat, Donations and Gift Aid.
- We budgeted Rs17.7M in 2022-23 but managed to collect approximately Rs18.8M
- Additional collections were made for the emergency appeal for the flooding in Sindh and Baluchistan.
- The breakdown of all donations is given in the table. 24% higher collections year on year basis which means we were able to cover more families, provide more Rashaan and responded to the emergency appeal to the best of our ability and undertake other projects aswell.

Once the registration process is completed we have to comply with the local laws and hence the auditors have to be appointed which will be part of the admin expenses.



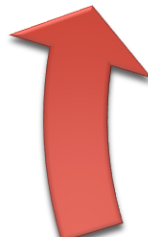
The overheads have been kept to the minimum and only a very small amount of bank charges were the part of it.

# Water Projects

• **Water is one of the most basic necessities of human life, but unfortunately, millions of people are trapped in a cycle of poverty and disease due to not having access to clean drinking water.**

• Helping the ummah with the bare necessities like clean water is significant. With your zakat donation, quench the thirst of those in need of your help, and see the change you've made in many areas in Pakistan.

• Water is an essential necessity needed to sustain life. However, although water may be in plentiful supply for those of us here in the developed countries, there are many millions of people around the world who simply do not have access to clean, safe drinking water.

Other than that we also completed 2 projects of Water Lines with Tanks and Motors in very deprived areas of Baluchistan.

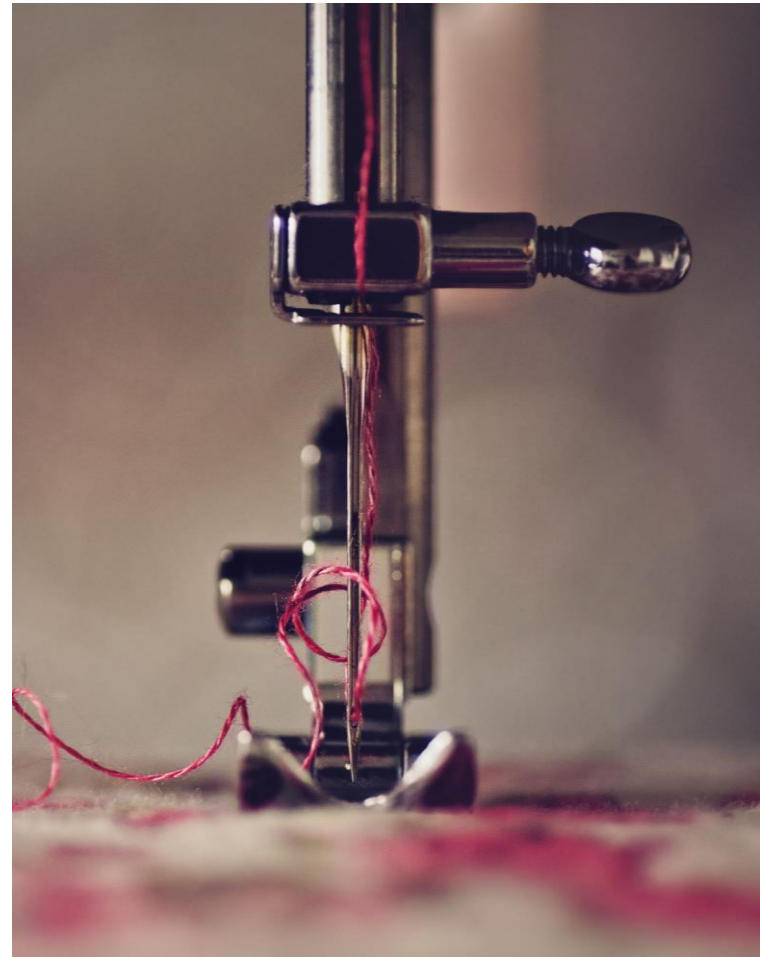

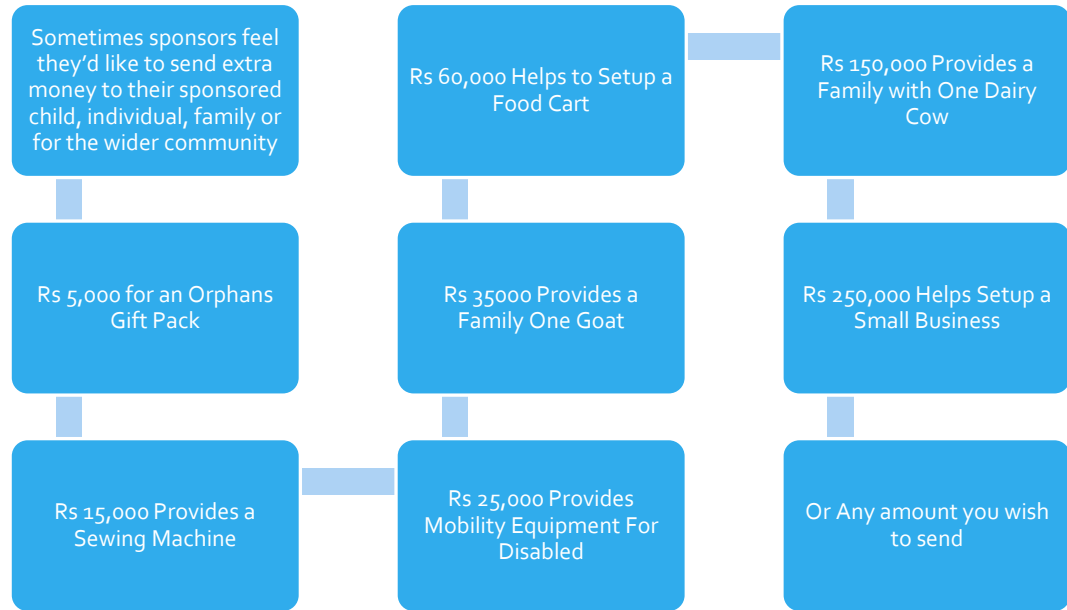
